Reporting requirement of the supply chain according to Art. 33, REACH Regulation

Products: Small domestic appliances (e. g. coffee machines, water kettles, grinders, milk frothers and fully automatic machines)

On June 27th, 2018 lead has been included in the candidate list of substances of very high concern according to Art. 59 of the REACH Regulation (1907/2006/EG).

All industrial associations, together with some member states of the EU, have been intervening for a long period of time against lead in the candidate list, as this recording inevitably leads to an unnecessary reporting flood along the supply chain. In a lot of areas in the electrical industry there is no alternative to lead, furthermore for the electrical industry lead is considerably regulated in the RoHS Directive (2011/65/EU).

Herewith Melitta meets its reporting requirement according to Art. 33 of the REACH Regulation and informs you, that in some sub-assemblies of our coffee machines, water kettles, grinder, milk frother and fully automatic machines, e. g. in the power plug, in electronic components and in electric motors the following substance is included in a concentration of > 0.1 %:

• lead (CAS 7439-92-1, EC 231-100-4)

It can be excluded that this substance will be released under normal or reasonably predictable application conditions.

This announcement has no influence on the RoHS Conformity of our products.

Our small domestic appliances do not contain other materials from the list of candidates according to article 59 (10) order (EG) no. 1907/2006 above 0,1 masses % (Status: January 23rd, 2024)
